

Who runs the art prize? - The prize is run by Women in Art CIC <https://www.womeninartcic.co.uk>

Who judges the work? - The list of judges can be viewed on the Holly Bush prize website at Meet the Team

How do I enter? - Go to [Zealous](#), upload all the details of your work and pay you fee, You will have to load one work first and pay then you can go back and load another for free.

What does it mean, I can enter 2 works? - It means you can enter 1 or 2 artworks for £18.

I can't fill the form in online what do I do? - Zealous have an online help system do ask them for help. You can always email us if you are having real difficulties or have questions hollybushprize@gmail.com

What if I don't want to write an artist's statement, I don't think I can? - That's ok you can enter without writing an Artist's statement but you won't be considered for the winning prize, just the runner-up prizes and you can still be in the exhibition. If you need help then try this [link](#)

How will I know you have received my entry? - If you completed online then it will tell you it is a success and Zealous will send you a confirmation email.

I won't be able to deliver or collect my work on the dates shown in the Terms and Conditions, does this matter? - You must be able to deliver or collect your work on the dates and times shown, or have someone do it for you. You may also use a delivery service. If your work does not turn up on time you may have to forfeit your place.

I have checked the terms and conditions and I won't be able to make the prize-giving will that matter? - You will not be considered for the top prize if you are unable to make the prize-giving but you can still be considered for the runner-up prizes.

Why does my work have to be no wider than 1 metre? - This is so that we can exhibit all 22 of the finalists work in the best possible way.

Why does my work have to be for sale? - The commission made from selling your work helps to fund next year's prize.

Why can I not sell my work for more than £3000? - The prize is for emerging artists and the judges and Women in Art consider this the maximum price the market will bear right now for a work by an emerging artist. Although this may be debatable, the work does need to be considered affordable to help it sell.

When will I find out if I am a Finalist? - The finalists will be announce no later than 18th May.
